

The San Francisco-based expert in Iran-made felt rugs heads to the galleries for the Designer Collection, a series honoring 20th-century art. Interior designer Alison Damonte's Sunrise blurs Frank Stella's famed color fields into a luminous 3-by-12-foot runner. Her 7-foot-square Tango rug loosens up Sol LeWitt's rigorous minimalism, overlapping two triangles against a solid ground to create gradations of teal/orange or white/gray. And her 8-by-10-foot You-Me rug likewise juxtaposes two shapes—a circle and a rectangle—to form a dissolving expanse of golden tones. All three are reversible, peaceindustry.com. circle 635 >
